Now OvaGraph users have access to a convenient Android app for quick data entry and ovulation calendar/graph viewing. Fairhaven Health released the OvaGraph fertility charting app for IOS users earlier this year.

Charting key fertility indicators allows trying-to-conceive couples to improve their chances of conceiving naturally by helping them pinpoint the woman's so-called "fertile window." When it comes to making babies, there are only a few days during the cycle that intercourse matters. Conception can only be achieved if sperm are ready and waiting in the woman's reproductive tract when ovulation occurs, that precise moment when the egg is released from the ovary. As a result, couples can increase their odds of becoming pregnant by having intercourse on the few days just before, and on, a woman's ovulation date. Tracking specific fertility indicators helps define that "fertile window."

With the [OvaGraph mobile app for Android](#) and IOS, women can record their fertility indicators such as cervical mucus consistency, basal body temperature (BBT) readings, ovulation test results, and [OvaCue fertility monitor](#) readings, all in one convenient place. Women can customize which charts are displayed, record cycle data for an unlimited number of cycles, and compare multiple cycles at once. Registered users can also print charts for any given cycle to bring in with them to their next doctor visit. Unlike other sites that offer limited free trials or paid premium upgrades, OvaGraph and both apps are 100% free, no strings attached.

At first, fertility charting may seem daunting and time consuming. OvaGraph hosts a community of women who are actively trying to conceive and charting their fertility. The forums – accessible directly through the app – serve as a safe haven where women can chat and ask questions about infertility, fertility charting, trying to conceive tips, and even pregnancy. Women often share personal experiences in hopes of helping one another and receiving some much needed support.

"The tools available to women at OvaGraph are invaluable, but I think the best aspect is the community of women helping one another through this difficult time," Dohman said. "We have moderators there to help interpret fertility charts, but even beyond that, OvaGraph has become a supportive, educational, and open environment for everyone.
