A few months ago, I was able to test out a few maternity and pregnancy products from Fairhaven Health, all of which I thought were useful and have been well used over the last few months! Since my little one arrived last week, I've been excited to try a handful of the best selling breastfeeding products (at no cost to facilitate this review), especially since that seems to be the only thing I do lately: feed the baby! Fairhaven Health is a leading provider for fertility, pregnancy, and nursing products are that doctor-designed and natural, and I have quite a few favorites already.

Another product that intrigued me from the start was the Milkies Milk-Saver. Anyone who has given birth has likely heard from numerous sources about the remarkable qualities of breastmilk, and how each drop is like "liquid gold". For those with low milk supply or struggling newborns, every single drop is important and worth saving. This is heavy duty, flexible, and BPA-free. Instead of a number of small disposable collection bags, this is one mega receptacle, and because of how sturdy it is, there is a very low possibility of it tearing or ripping, and it could definitely withstand the dishwasher cycle over and over again. Personally, I don't tend to leak very much, if at all, so while I was able to try it out, and it comfortably collected some milk, it was quite a cumbersome contraption to insert just to collect a drop or two of milk. For women who tend to leak more or have a tendency to collect milk from the non-nursing breast, this will probably be a godsend and will get a lot of use.
