The first annoyance that comes to mind regarding breastfeeding is the milk leakage and having to keep that under control. I don't know about you, and I'm sure every woman is different, but it usually takes me a few weeks/months to reach a supply/demand equilibrium with my infants, and nursing pads are a must. I'm a reusable nursing pad fan to begin with, so I knew I'd love these. I was given a huge package of disposable nursing pads at my baby shower, and I thought I'd give them a try, but I ended up not liking them AT ALL. They felt noisy, crunchy, less absorbent, and I never liked the sticky square feature on this particular brand. I'd so much rather something soft and natural right up on my skin, especially raw and tender skin.



These are a very far cry from anything like those horrible disposables. They are made of eco-friendly natural fiber bamboo and microfiber, so you're getting the best of both worlds: soft and natural as well as absorbent and easy to care for. The bamboo layer goes against your skin and the micro backing offers excellent protection from milk ever reaching your clothes. An inner layer of ultra-absorbent microfiber can handle quite a large amount of milk. These are much bigger than any nursing pad I've tried, so you're getting a lot of coverage and a lot of absorption capacity. I just can't get over how very comfortable and so soft they are! I've felt completely dry and completely comfortable while wearing these nursing pads. I even dumped two Tablespoons of water onto a pad to see if there would be any leaking, and it handled the liquid easily. No leaking on the other side and no spilling off the pad. These pads are really going to be your best friends.
